KEY FEATURES

Dunlop & Johnston, Inc. completed both the Elementary and Middle School projects for the Madison Local School District in time for the August 2013 school year. We were responsible for the general trades package which consisted of the excavation and site work with new utilities, paving, concrete, masonry, structural and miscellaneous steel, aluminum windows and doors, interiors, painting, floor covering, wood floors, casework and other accessories. Each project included a complete site development package including a new water service, storm and sanitary utilities, parking and lawn areas.

The Elementary school structure is masonry bearing walls with precast concrete slab for the second floor. The roof framing is steel or masonry bearing joist and deck. What makes the building unique is a distinctive open glass clerestory entry area and an open second floor hallway. The exterior is masonry veneer and metal siding.

This elementary school building includes 34 classrooms, gymnasium, stage and student dining areas. The new construction of this building replaced the existing elementary school for Madison.
